#### YOUR ATTENTION PLEASE

The cold weather is coming. Your children will need to be wearing snow pants and boots for warmth. Please make sure everything is labeled with your child's

name!! We believe that fresh air even for a short amount of time is beneficial to the children and will try to be outside every day if possible. 4 day and 5 day classes will play outside at the beginning of the day. If it is too wet or frigid we will play in our indoor basement playroom. Teachers will let you know if there is a weather related change to the schedule, but the general rule of thumb is wear all appropriate outdoor attire everyday!

#### Three Year Old Classes

Your child should arrive at school with boots and snow pants in their backpacks. Three year olds outdoor play is at the end of the school session. Rule of thumb...send all appropriate outdoor attire everyday!

#### 2+ and Turning 3 classes...

Your child will utilize the basement


playroom during the winter months. Although they should always be dressed for warmth to enter and leave the building (coats, hats, mittens). Rule of thumb...Snow pants and boots are not necessary. If you choose to wear boots to and from school please remember to send shoes to change into. Tie/Velcro shoes are best. Please avoid Crocs or slip on shoes for safety reasons.
