



St. David's Nursery School will offer our camp program this year. Begin your child's summer here! <u>Open to children who are currently in our 3 day</u> <u>3s, 4 day and 5 day classes</u>. Little Camp on the Corner extends your child's school year with activities that are filled with fun, imagination and discovery.

Little Camp on the Corner will run over two weeks (eight days) from May 28-June 6. (Week 1 meets Tuesday through Friday and Week 2 meets Monday through Thursday) from 9:00- 12:00. Little Camp on the Corner will be taught by Mrs. Kwilosz and Mrs. Randall with Mrs. Zuhr as the Teachers Aide.

Camp is limited to the first 24 children to sign up.
